|                | Liquids, gels and aerosols packed in carry-on must follow the 3-1-1 liquids rule:  • 3.4 ounces or less per container  • 1-quart size, clear, plastic, zip top bag (all liquids must fit in bag)  • 1 bag per passenger  Review the prohibited items list for both carry-on and checked baggage.  If purchasing a baggage lock, be sure to look for those that are TSA recognized.  Tape a card with your name and contact information on your electronics. |

| □<br>□<br>har  | Pack items in layers (shoes one layer, clothes one layer, electronics one layer, etc.)  Firearms are <u>only allowed in checked baggage</u> and must be unloaded, placed in a locked, d-sided container and declared to your airline.  All <u>fireworks</u> contain explosive materials and are not permitted in checked or carry-on  |
|                | Pack large electronics on top layer of carry-on for screening accessibility.  Place your 3-1-1 bag with liquids, gels and aerosols in the front pocket of your carry-on for essibility.  If traveling with a pet, be sure to bring a leash so carriers can be properly screened.  |
